We believe that wearing school uniform encourages children to be neat and tidy for work, prevents discrimination, reduces arguments about clothes at home, makes recognition of pupils easier and fosters a pride in our school.

Uniform List- Winter

Mid - grey skirt, pinafore, tunic or trousers.

Red school sweatshirt or cardigan

Red or white polo shirt or white shirt

White socks or red or grey tights

Black shoes- NO TRAINERS

Uniform List - Summer

Red gingham checked dress

Grey shorts / skirt with red or white polo shirt or white shirt

Red school sweatshirt or cardigan.

White socks

Black shoes - NO TRAINERS

Sun Hat

For safety reasons, trainers, boots, sling backs, open toed sandals or high heeled shoes should not be worn in school.

Suppliers

The Brigade and My Clothing online shops are available for ordering uniform.

Generic items such as white polo shirts and school skirts or trousers can be purchased from most supermarket chains.

Pre-Loved Uniform

The school PTFA provide a selection of pre-loved uniform which is available to all families. The items which are usually stocked are cardigans, jumpers, trousers, dresses, skirts and PE kit. A selection is available from the rail in the office porch.

High Expectations

All children are encouraged to keep themselves neat and tidy and to take pride in their general appearance. All clothing and personal belongings should be clearly marked with the child's name.

Jewellery and Make-up

Children are not encouraged to wear earrings or other jewellery to school. Studs are permitted for those children who have pierced ears. During P.E. lessons, studs will need to be removed or covered with surgical tape. In general terms, you are advised not to allow your child to wear jewellery at school in case of loss, damage or injury.

Make-up, including nail varnish, is not appropriate in school and should also not be worn.
