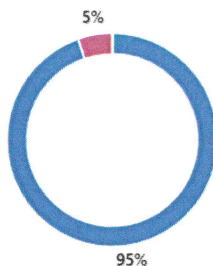

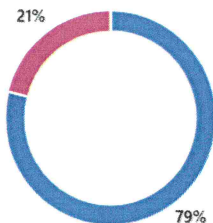

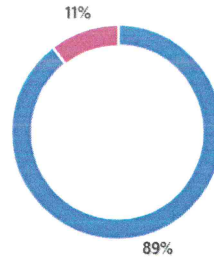

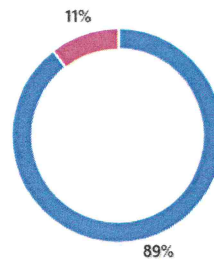

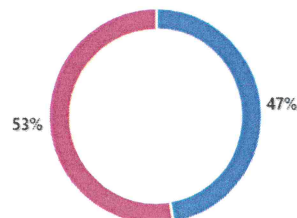

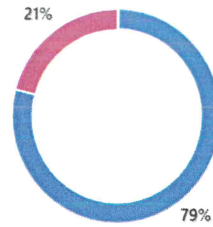
7. My child receives appropriate homework for their age.

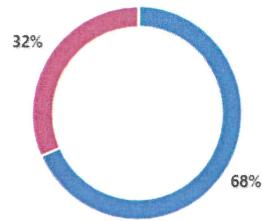
8. The school makes sure that pupils are well behaved.

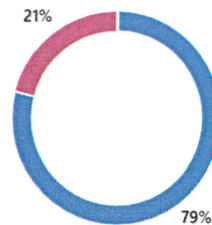

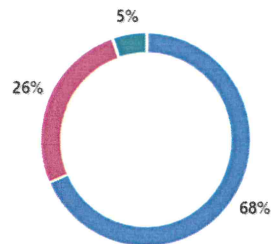

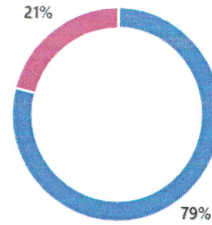

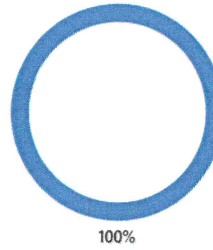
