#1 Membership

New Forest School Sport Partnership Infant Schools Service Level Agreement

For the period 1st September 2025 to 31st August 2026

1. Guiding Principles

- i. 'The School' agrees to support their PE Lead to deliver the priorities within the New Forest Primary School Sport Partnership Policy Document.
- ii. The New Forest School Sport Partnership agrees to provide support to 'The School' in matters concerning the PE and sport premium funding for primary schools.
- iii. 'The School' agrees to inform the New Forest School Sport Partnership of their numbers on role for the 2025-26 academic year before Friday 10th October 2025.

2. Financial Arrangements

- i. An annual membership will be paid to Testwood School (hosts of the New Forest School Sport Partnership) in 2025-26 academic year. **Paid in full before Friday 10th October 2025.**
- ii. All new joining schools will return their signed SLA and membership forms via email **before Friday 19th September 2025 to avoid their joining fee.**
- iii. All financial transactions between 'The School' and Testwood School will require invoices, prompted by Testwood School finance department.
- iv. 'The School' agrees to provide the New Forest School Sport Partnership with a purchase order number. On receipt of the purchase order number, the New Forest School Sport Partnership will confirm 'The Schools' membership and issue an invoice to 'The School'.

3. Working Arrangements

- i. The New Forest School Sport Partnership will continue to offer a service to 'The School', through teacher training (Continuing Professional Development), subject leader training, school sport competitions and school-club-link support.
- ii. There will be flexibility on both the part of 'The School' and the New Forest School Sport Partnership to adjust these arrangements as and when required, with the support of both partners. (For example, if you would like to use a programme to contribute towards a whole school Inset or additional delegates onto another programme.)

4. Line Management and Support

- i. The PE Co-ordinator will be supported through a management group consisting of the following:
 - a) The Schools Head Teacher and/or Senior Management Team
 - b) PE Co-ordinators Line Manager
 - c) New Forest School Sport Partnership Manager

5. Review

This agreement will be reviewed by 'The Schools' Head Teacher and the New Forest School Sport Partnership Manager in June/July 2026.


