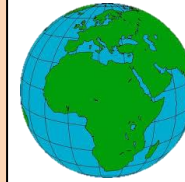

What's it all about?

In this topic your child will learn to draw and follow maps of the local area.

Outcome:

At the end of the topic to show what we have learnt, the children will be able to talk about how maps and instructions are used to create routes.

In **D.T.** children will learn how to make a stable structure.

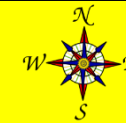
In **Science** the children will be investigating plants and the environment.
