Outcome:

The children will be able to discuss the life of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole and discuss their legacy.

In addition to the topic based learning outlined above, your child will also be learning to do the following:

In English the children will write narratives to entertain based on 'How the Tortoise Got His Shell' and describe real events about Florence Nightingale.

In Maths the children will recognise numbers to 100, add, subtract, use simple multiplication and understand sharing as division.

In R.E. children will be identifying and talking about special places.

In P.S.H.E. the children will be learning about 'Fake is a Mistake' with Heartsmart.

In Music the children will learn to explore, respond to and recognise solo sounds and layers of sounds.

In Science the children will be learning more about plants and the lifecycle of a plant.

In P.E. the children will develop co-ordination when using equipment and will develop agility skills in order to react and respond quickly.

Ways to support your child at home:

- ❖ Find and discuss interesting facts about Florence Nightingale.
- ❖ Make an information poster about the life of Florence Nightingale.
- ❖ Visit the grave of Florence Nightingale at St Margaret's Church in Wellow near Romsey.
- ❖ Read at least 3 times a week with your child.
- ❖ Practise weekly spellings.
