If the decision to proceed is made, a report will be taken to a future Executive Lead Member for Children's Services Decision Day seeking approval for a statutory Public Notice to be published. It is anticipated that the Public Notice will be published in the Autumn Term.



After the date of publication, there will be a four-week period in which any representations can be made. After the conclusion of this period, the County Council will decide whether or not to proceed with the proposal. If approved, it would be implemented no earlier than 1 September 2026.

Reminder: Parent Workshop with Emily Sleep

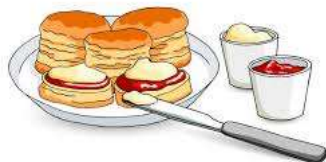
Emily from Solent Mind will be running an information session on Tuesday 8th from 9am to 9.30am. Please come along to find out about how you can support your child to manage their emotions.
