Or simply scan this QR code to sign up.

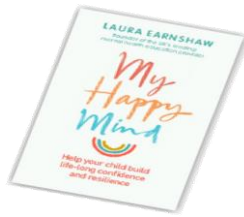


Once you have created your account, you will receive an email with the next steps on downloading the app.
