Easter Egg Collection

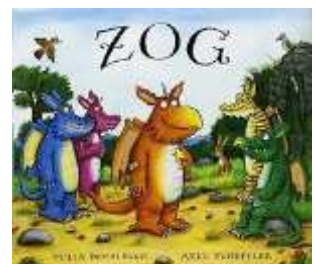

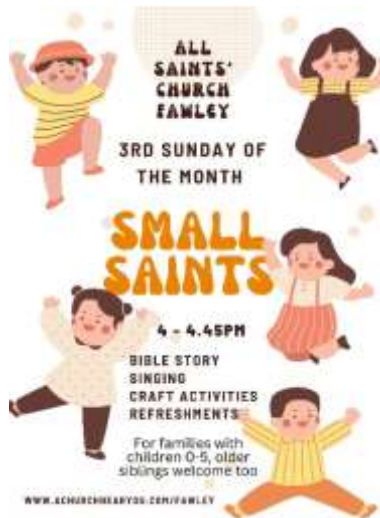
School Uniform
