#TickingTheBoxes

-  **✓ PROTECT**
  - ✓ Use tick repellent
  - ✓ Wear long sleeves and trousers
  - ✓ Tuck trousers into socks
-  **✓ CHECK**
  - ✓ Yourself and Kids (especially: hairline, ears, armpits, navel, groin)
  - ✓ Pets (& keep tick treatments up to date)
-  **✓ REMOVE**
  - ✓ Use a tick-removal tool or fine-pointed tweezers
  - ✓ Always follow correct removal techniques
-  **✓ OBSERVE**
  - ✓ Look out for symptoms, which **MAY** include: a 'bull's-eye rash', flu-like symptoms, migratory muscle/joint pain, nausea
  - ✓ If you unwell, **go to your GP**

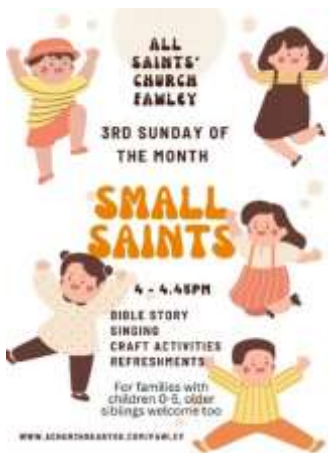


## School Uniform
