School structure September 2026

As we begin planning for the next academic year, I would like to share some information about the structure of our classes from September.

After careful consideration of cohort sizes and to ensure the best possible learning environment for all children, we will be organising the school into the following classes:

- Chestnut Class Year 1/2 class
- Holly Class Reception class

We are pleased to let you know that we have appointed Miss Suckley as our permanent class teacher from September 2026. Miss Suckley has experience of teaching in Key Stage One and has taught in many local schools. Miss Suckley will be teaching Chestnut Class and Mrs Whitfield will cover the teaching for one day a week. Miss Suckley is very excited to be part of the Manor team, she will be attending several of our school transition afternoons to get to know the children.

Holly Class will be taught by Mrs Welling and Mrs Munns.

Mrs Wright, from Marchwood CofE Infant School, will continue as the school SENDCo.

The teachers will continue to deliver a carefully planned curriculum that meets the needs of each year group within the class, ensuring that every child is both supported and challenged.

Holly Class Trip to Lepe Beach

Holly Class had a fantastic trip to Lepe on Wednesday. The children took part in a seaside safari, litter pick and they created a piece of art work in the style of Andy Goldsworthy, the artist that the children have been studying this term.

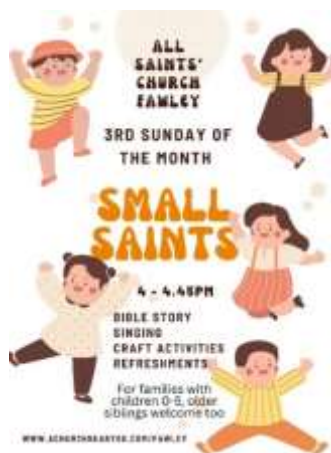


School Uniform
